



COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS & GUIDELINES

1. Parents and spectators will be asked to bring their own chairs and sit down each foul line beyond first and third base or behind the outfield fence.
 2. Masks will not be mandatory but encouraged and will be available for purchase for those wanting one.
 3. Hand sanitizer will be provided for each dugout and will be available but also encouraged for all participants to bring their own.
 4. Any person experiencing symptoms of sickness will be prohibited from entering or will be asked to leave if this were to occur during the tournament.
 5. Dugouts will be limited to a max of 3 players and 2 coaches at a time and the rest of the team will be behind the dugout 6 feet apart.
 6. One of our staff or a designated team player will be responsible for the retrieval of foul balls and then sanitizing them before they will be allowed back into play.
 7. All players will bring their own water bottles with name on them and their own labeled snacks - no team coolers allowed.
 8. No sharing of equipment will be allowed - each catcher should have his own gear and each player should have his own helmet - all bat bags outside the dugout.
 9. No pregame or post game handshakes or physical contact of any kind unless it is part of on field game play.
 10. Umpires will be asked to officiate the games behind the mound area and should not handle game balls.
 11. No coaches will be allowed on the field to argue with an umpire and must call the umpire over towards the dugout area if he has a question.
 12. All teams will be required to clean their dugout after the game thoroughly and then our staff will disinfect all hard surfaces, bat racks and/or other spaces.
 13. Special attention will be paid to all bathroom areas and an additional washing station added if possible.
 14. Sunflower seeds and gum will be prohibited.
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
